
In accordance with the Metropolitan Police Department's regulations, permission is hereby granted to Perry Redd to conduct a march on Monday, September 2, 2024, from 1300 hours (assembly time), 1330 hours (starting time), to 1500 hours (disbanding time), consisting of: 50 participants, signs, and placards.

The march will form at the 1325 Pennsylvania Avenue, NW, and march southeast on Pennsylvania Avenue, south on 3<sup>rd</sup> street, west on Independence Avenue, southwest on Washington Avenue, south on South Capitol Street, east on I street, south on Half Street to 1500 South Capitol Street, SE, Nationals Park, where they will rally and disband.

Participants shall use one lane of roadway mentioned along the above route unless otherwise directed by Metropolitan Police Department or other competent authority.

**SUBJECT TO THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS**

1. Applicant and all participants in the assembly herein authorized must comply with all the conditions of this assembly approval plan and applicable regulations and instructions issued by the Metropolitan Police Department.
2. The Metropolitan Police Department reserves the right to revoke this Assembly Plan Approval at any time, should the event present a clear and present danger to public health or safety, or if the applicant in the assembly herein authorized violates any conditions of this approval plan.
3. The applicant agrees that the assembly shall terminate at the expiration of the time specified herein; applicant assumes responsibility for the orderly disbanding of the assembly and for the orderly dispersal of all participants.
4. Applicant agrees that the area of the assembly shall be left in substantially the same condition as it was prior to the assembly authorized herein.
5. This plan approval is applicable only for the use of the area designated herein or any area as may hereafter be designated by the Chief, Metropolitan Police Department, or his representative.
6. Applicant acknowledges the fact that we are currently in a public emergency due to the COVID-19 pandemic and agrees to follow all local and federal guidelines related to masking, social distancing, and other safety measures in place at the time of the event.
7. It is understood that Perry Redd will be in charge of this assembly, and the person that the Metropolitan Police Department should contact in managing this event.
